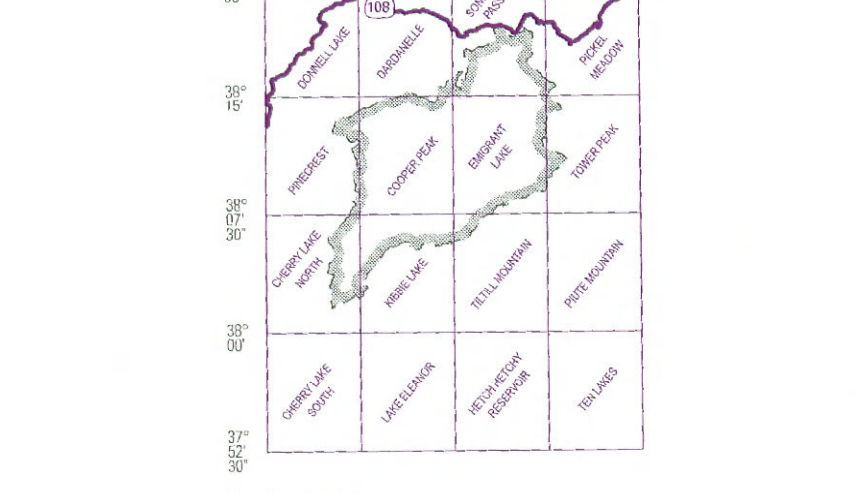

FOREST SERVICE MAP
Contracted by USDA Forest Service Pacific Southwest Region, Geospatial Services, Yreka, CA in 2010 from USGS 1:24,000 scale USGS/USFS quadrangle modified with digital USFS generated data.
